Aaron McDermid**, now in his third year with the Chorale, is completing a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Choral Conducting, with a minor in Composition, at the University of Arizona. In addition to his conducting schedule, he regularly tours with an a cappella men's ensemble, *Chanson*. He is an award-winning composer with works performed by school, church, civic, and professional choirs throughout the United States.
